

# First results from Census 2021 in England and Wales – Population and Household Estimates<sup>1</sup>

#### In Summary

- The usual resident population in the Midlands Engine area was 10,371,800 on Census Day (21<sup>st</sup> March 2021), an increase of 6.2% (+601,621) when compared with Census Day 2011. Englandwide the population increased by 6.6% to 56,489,800 on Census Day 2021.
- The Midlands Engine area followed the national trend where there were declines in five age bands; aged 4 years and under, 15-19 years old, 20-24 years old, 40-44 years old and 45-49 years old. However, there are age bands with significant percentage increases; those aged 70-74 years old, those aged 75-79 years old and those aged 90 years and over.

#### **Full Briefing**

- The usual resident population in the Midlands Engine area was 10,371,800 on Census Day (21<sup>st</sup> March 2021), an increase of 6.2% (+601,621) when compared with Census Day 2011. Englandwide the population increased by 6.6% to 56,489,800 on Census Day 2021.
- The Midlands Engine population can be split by 5,269,900 females (+6.4%, +316,929 since Census Day 2011) and 5,102,200 males (+5.9%, +284,992 since Census Day 2011). In England, there were 28,833,500 females (+7.0%) and 27,656,300 males (+6.1%).
- Within the Midlands Engine, there were four local authorities where the population decreased since the Census day in 2011. Chesterfield population decreased by approximately 188 residents (-0.2%), Newcastle-under-Lyme decreased by approximately 571 residents (-0.5%), Staffordshire Moorlands decreased by approximately 1,306 residents (-1.3%) and North East Lincolnshire decreased by 2,716 residents (-1,7%).
- Derbyshire Dales total population increased by 384 (+0.5%) but notably there was a decrease of 171 (-0.5%) of males.
- Within the Midlands Engine, the largest increase in population was in Birmingham (+71,855) this
  was also the biggest change across the country. This was followed by Leicester (+38,761 12<sup>th</sup>
  highest increase out of all areas) and Sandwell (+33,837, 18<sup>th</sup> highest out of all areas).

• In the Midlands Engine area there were 4,288,500 households with at least one usual resident on Census Day 2021.

### Population Age Breakdown

• As seen in the following table, the Midlands Engine area followed the national trend where there were declines in five age bands; aged 4 years and under (-6.3%, Eng. -7.3%), 15-19 years old (-3.8%, Eng. -3.6%) 20-24 years old (-3.7%, Eng. -5.0%), 40-44 years old (-13.1%, Eng. -7.9%) and 45-49 years old (-9.8%, Eng. -7.1%).

• For the Midlands Engine area, the highest percentage increases were in those aged 70-74 years old (+34.4%, Eng. +36.8%), aged 90 years and over (+26.4%, Eng. +23.4%) and those aged 75-79 years old (+25.9%, Eng. +22.1%).

## **Population Density**

- Since Census Day 2011, across the Midlands Engine area the number of residents per square kilometre decreased in four local authorities; North East Lincolnshire (-14), Chesterfield (-3), Newcastle-under-Lyme (-3) and Staffordshire Moorlands (-2). A further two local authorities remained the same; Derbyshire Dales and High Peak.
- The Midlands Engine area at 380 residents per square kilometre was below the England-wide figure of 434 residents per square kilometre.
