Health Planning

Members of the Midlands Engine Health Board came together for an extraordinary meeting to review the delivery priorities for Midlands Engine Health and to align them with the Midlands Engine Business Plan currently in development. The Board will now consider refreshing its membership, producing an asset map of the strengths in the health and life sciences sector in the region and creating an action plan, outlining goals and a workplan for achieving them.

Mental Health and Productivity Pilot

On 30 November, MHPP hosted a visit by Jonathan Marron DG OHID and Kate Farrington DG DWP to share the learning and outline how MHPP is contributing to growth and workplace mental wellbeing agenda. The event included a session with employees and employers who have been involved in the programme to-date.
